● **Table B1** (*portion that appears on page 62*)

Look in **Table B1: IESNA Lighting Design**. Under the boldface Location/Task entry **Reading**, note that the row labeled **White boards** contains the letter “B” (indicating recommended illuminance category “B”) in the column labeled **Illuminance (Vertical) Category or Value (lux)**. However, the correct recommendation at this point in **Table B1** should be category “D” as category “B” is too dim for the associated location/task.

Seven illuminance categories (A through G) are described and given numerical values in **Table 1: Determination of Illuminance Categories**, located on page 10 of RP-1-04.
